Notice of Temporary Traffic Control Plan
S. FIFTH AVE (E. Liberty to E. William Street)
August 4, 2010 to November 1, 2011

Location and Limits of Affected Area:

South Fifth Avenue from Liberty to William Street .

Description of Work:

An underground parking structure will be constructed under S. Fifth Ave between Liberty Street and William Street, and the street reinstalled after the parking structure construction.

Temporary Construction Traffic Control Plan:

Beginning Wednesday, August 4, South Fifth Ave will be closed to vehicular southbound between Liberty and William Street. A restricted one-way lane will be provided on the west side of S. Fifth Avenue between Liberty and William Street for use by AATA buses and authorized Federal Building tenants. South bound vehicle traffic will be detoured at Beakes south to First Street, east at William Street. Southbound truck traffic will be detoured at Beakes to Main Street. See attached map for details.

Pedestrian Access

Pedestrian access will be maintained on one side of the street at all times.

During this work the traffic may experience delays within and beyond the areas influenced by the construction. Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes. Traffic signs and other devices will be posted to notify and direct those approaching and traveling through the project work zone. To maintain the safety of all, please reduce speeds and drive cautiously. We thank you in advance for your patience as these necessary public infrastructure improvements are completed.
